

Mini Piñata

This is a fun and easy craft to make. Celebrate National Hispanic Heritage Month from September 15th-October 15th by creating your own mini piñata.

Supplies Needed:

- Piñata template
- Scissors (**not included in kit**)
- Masking tape (**not included in kit**)
- Crepe paper-multi color
- Glue stick (**not included in kit**)



Instructions:

1. With scissors, cut out each piece traced out on the template. There should be 18 small numbered rectangle/square pieces and 2 large pieces shaped as the burro (donkey). (See picture below).



2. Use the large piece that is numbered to identify where the smaller pieces should be adhered with tape. (See picture below). Once adhered, it should work much like a door hinge. Make sure the tape is all on one side so all pieces' fold inward.



3. Turn the piece over and begin taping the smaller pieces to each other. (See picture below).



4. Now tape the last piece on to complete the burro. (See picture below).



5. Fold crepe paper in half and begin cutting slits half way through the paper. Make sure not to cut all the way through. (See picture below).



6. Glue the top half of the crepe paper to the burro leaving the frayed ends loose. Work from the bottom up. Continue until the entire donkey is covered. (See picture below).
