

Teen Take & Make: Paper Bag Stars



Supplies:


- 8 paper bags
- String

Supplies needed:

- Glue (stick or liquid)
- Markers, paint or whatever art supplies you want
- Scissors

Instructions:

- 1. If desired, decorate all sides of each paper bag with your art supplies, including the sides and bottom of the bag.
- 2. Lay one bag flat on a surface, with the front of the bag face-up. Place glue all down the front of the bag, and place another bag directly on top (facing the same direction). Repeat the process until all bags are glued together in a stack. Be sure that all of the tops (openings) of the bags are facing the same direction as you layer them.
- 3. Cut each side of the open part of the bags into a point, like paper snowflakes.





- 4. Place glue all down the front of the top bag, and connect it to the bottom bag in a "fan" motion. You should now see the star shape.
- 5. Hold the glued part of the bags until the glue begins to dry and the bags remain glued together when released.
- 6. Create a hole in the top part of the star, either with a pencil or a hole punch and tie a string through the hole to act as a hanger.
