

# Magnolia Leaf Book Page Wreath



## Supplies included:

- About 15 pages of a book
- Cardboard wreath
- Twine
- Cardboard leaf template

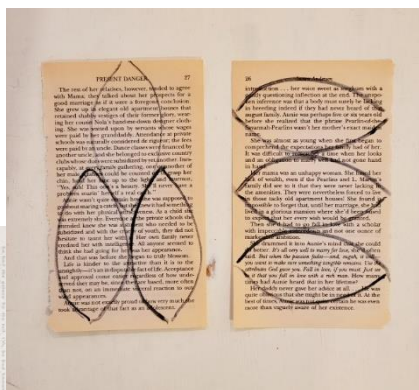
## Supplies needed:

- Pencil
- Scissors
- Craft glue or hot glue

**Step One:** Slip twine through hole in the cardboard wreath and knot the twine.



**Step Two:** Use the template to draw the leaf onto a stack of book pages. You should be able to fit at least 3-4 on each page. Cut them out - it's easiest to do multiple pages at a time. You will need about 45 leaves total.



**Tip:** Fold the leaf lengthwise, then again fold one end up. This will give some dimension to your wreath once it's hanging.



**Step Three:** Starting at the twine loop, apply the glue to the folded end of the leaf and add the leaves one at a time to the cardboard wreath. Stagger the leaves to give a natural look to the pattern and cover any gaps. Work counterclockwise around the wreath.
